Qualifications

Winners will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievements, leadership as shown by their extra-curricular activities, offices held and other services to the school or the community, with thoughtful consideration of Need, Good Personal Behavior and Outstanding Educational Credits. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States of America, Polish ethnic and ancestry on either paternal or maternal side, a resident of Nassau or Suffolk County.

Applicants must be accepted for attendance at a four or two-year accredited college, university, or a technical/vocational institute.

All applications shall remain the property of the PACA, Inc. and The General Pulaski Foundation Scholarship Committee. The committee reserves all rights to seek further data and/or information as to eligibility and its final determination and decision.
